




**DOUBLE-ACTION REVOLVER:**

The demonstration shall commence with the firearm unloaded and locked with the firearm safety device with which it is required to be delivered, if applicable. While maintaining muzzle awareness, that is, the firearm is pointed in a safe direction, preferably down at the ground, and trigger discipline, that is, the trigger finger is outside of the trigger guard and alongside of the firearm frame, at all times, the firearm recipient shall correctly and safely perform the following:



1.	Open the cylinder.	A black and white photograph showing a person's hands opening the cylinder of a double-action revolver. The cylinder is being rotated outwards from the frame.
2.	Visually and physically inspect each chamber, to ensure that the revolver is unloaded.	A black and white photograph showing a person's hands inspecting the chambers of a double-action revolver. The cylinder is open, and the chambers are being visually inspected.
3.	Remove the firearm safety device. If the firearm safety device prevents any of the previous steps, remove the firearm safety device during the appropriate step. 4.	While maintaining muzzle awareness and trigger discipline, load one dummy round into a chamber of the cylinder and rotate the cylinder so that the round is in the next-to-fire position	A black and white photograph showing a person's hands loading a dummy round into a chamber of a double-action revolver. The cylinder is open, and the round is being inserted into one of the chambers.

<b>6.</b>	Open the cylinder and eject the round	
<b>7.</b>	Visually and physically inspect each chamber to ensure that the revolver is unloaded	
<b>8.</b>	Apply the firearm safety device, if applicable
